If I could invent something new, I would invent organs printing machines. This idea is inspired by the global health challenges that several people are facing each day. Every day, thousands of people die waiting for an organ transplant and every ten minutes, another candidate is added to the waiting list. He was at the University College Hospital in Ibadan for months. His family spent a huge amount of money on tests and drugs. On the long run, there was the need for a liver transplant as his liver had been damaged beyond repair. With this, an organ donor was needed which was later gotten in India. Before all necessary documents were ready, he kicked the bucket due to the fact that the arrangement for the organ donor took a long period of time to be perfected and his health couldn't carry it again. Had it been there were organs printing machines this neighbour of mine would have been alive today because immediately when his liver failed another liver would have been printed for him without delay.

Millions of people worldwide need new kidneys, livers, hearts and lungs because their organs stopped working. The wait is long, tiring and many people don't survive it. Only about one hundred and forty-four thousand organs per year are donated and transplanted around the world. Organ's printing machines are seriously needed to alleviate the health challenges. The invention of the organs printing machine will also help in reducing health care cost as the average cost for a kidney transplant is equivalent to \$442,500 which many people cannot and will not be able to afford. Many patients died before they could get organ transplant. The invention of organs printing machines will be live saver and a game changer!!!
